In the absence of a Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) and within the above research framework, we are looking for potential research projects (ideas) which will address these objectives.

The Research Projects (RO1, R21 type) should focus on Minority Health and Health Disparities research. The goal is to promote innovative research on these areas to advance current understanding of mechanisms leading to health disparities and to develop and test interventions that will reduce these health disparities. Projects (basic, applied, social and behavioral, clinical and translational research) that expand the inquiry into the mechanisms in behavior and biology that lead to disparities as well as integrate the environmental, social, and cultural factors that affect these disparities, are encouraged.
